

Workshop Series

The myBlueprint Workshop Series provides three Workshop sessions to learners with time to **actively engage in career and life planning, with the support of their teachers**. When high schools choose to engage in the myBlueprint Workshop Series, they will be provided with a host who will deliver **three separate one-hour virtual workshops** directly to learners and teachers together.

The Workshops are scheduled across three dates and are streamed directly into classrooms. The Workshops are intended to be offered to the **whole school** and/or with **specific cohorts** of learners/educators.

A **workshop primer session** and/or webinar is offered to participating staff prior to the commencement of the three workshops.



1. Workshop #1: Who Am I Surveys

This workshop will help learners answer the question: "Who Am I?"

Learners will have time to complete 5 assessments to learn and discover more about themselves, including Learning Styles, Myers-Briggs Personality, Holland Interests, Knowledge, and Motivations.

2. Workshop #2: Occupation Search and Portfolios

This workshop will help learners answer questions: "What are my opportunities?" and "What do I want to become?"

Learners will explore occupations and compare comprehensive information on job outlooks, salary ranges, and more, including the ability to identify occupations that are a good match. Through the use of portfolios, they will document and reflect on learning as well as easily share progress with parents, teachers, or guidance.

3. Workshop #3: High School Plan

This workshop will help learners answer the question: "What is my plan for achieving my goals?"

Learners will visually plan courses, track progress toward graduation, and instantly identify post-secondary eligibility for opportunities in all destinations.
