KC'S First Bus Ride – Order no. **700107.VH** (10 min.)

This entertaining program helps young KC overcome his anxiety over his first bus ride to school. Fully animated, KC's First Bus Ride takes children through the safety rules of riding the bus - Never stick your hand out of the window, Remain seated until the bus stops - are some of the topics covered. Approved by the National Highway Safety Administration and recommended for children 3 - 6 years of age.

Pooh's Great School Bus Adventure – Order no. **701582.VH**

Pooh, Piglet, Tigger, and friends demonstrate safety rules and proper behavior as they ride the school bus by themselves for the first time. A catchy song helps them recall safety rules that Christopher Robin has taught them. Features big-as-life "puppetronics" characters seen on the "Welcome to Pooh Corner" television series to help children review school bus safety rules in four areas: waiting for the bus, loading and riding the bus, and unloading.

Here Comes Our Bus – Order No. **700107.VH** (8 min. 1979)

This program encourages school bus safety and demonstrates normal safety precautions as well as emergency drills.

Riding Cool to School – Order No. **700851.VH** (16 min. 1983)

School bus safety presented by a cast of three puppets plus live action. Safety rules regarding getting to the bus stop, boarding the bus, riding and getting off the bus safely are presented and reinforced with music and songs.

RAIN OR SHINE: School Bus Safety and You - Order No. **800140.VH** (10 min PE 1996)

A musical from beginning to end! Safety rules are presented in rhyme and song that children (K-4) will eagerly sing along. Clever lyrics teach kids what to do - and what not to do - from the time they leave home, walk to the bus stop, safely get on the bus and ride to school. Additional up-tempo lyrics cover other safety tips for the ride home and walking from the bus stop to home.

Good Morning, Mr. Johnson – Order No. **705187.VH** (15 min. 1997)

A school bus safety video which accomplishes much...it encourages student judgment. It strengthens bus discipline. It enhances the driver image. It protects passenger lives. This program is essentially a solid lecture on school bus conduct, in the laboratory framework of a morning bus trip to school.

Just Can't Get Enough Safety – Order No. **705186.VH**

The legendary Sugar Bear leads an entire school in its new program for school bus safety. He is full of ideas on how young people can be Safety Smart from the moment they leave their homes to their safe return. The video deals clearly with the matter of distractions which are involved with a high percentage of school bus accidents.

Kids For Safety – Order No. **705851.VH**

This program combines live-action scenarios and colourful graphics to teach students all about bus safety. Advising viewers to be part of the "bus safety team", a friendly host presents easy-to-learn rules for keeping safety on the way to the bus stop and keeping safe while at the bus stop. Each live-action scenario models appropriate behaviour while riding the bus and demonstrates the proper steps each child should take to get on and off the bus safely. "Danger Zones" are also explained and illustrated.
