MINISTER'S DETERMINATION

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL
Pursuant to Regulation 87-83 under the <u>Clean Environment Act</u>
August 31, 2017
File Number: 4561-3-1468

- 1. In accordance with section 6(6) of the Regulation, it has been determined that the undertaking may proceed following approval under all other applicable acts and regulations.
- 2. Commencement of this undertaking must occur within three years of the date of this Determination. Should commencement not be possible within this time period the undertaking must be registered under the *Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation* (87-83) <u>Clean Environment Act</u> again, unless otherwise stated by the Minister of Environment and Local Government (DELG).
- 3. The proponent shall adhere to all obligations, commitments, monitoring and mitigation measures presented in the document entitled, "Environmental Impact Registration Victoria Street Culvert Upgrade City of Edmundston dated July 2017", as well as all those identified in subsequent correspondence during the registration review. Additionally, the proponent shall submit a summary table detailing the status of each condition listed in this Determination to the Manager of the Environmental Assessment Section of DELG every 6 months from the date of this Determination until such a time that all the Conditions have been met.
- 4. The proponent shall complete one of the archaeological assessment options to be submitted for review and approval by the Manager, EA Section, DELG.
 - a) Complete archaeological monitoring of ground disturbing activities which would be completed by a qualified, permitted archaeologist, who would be present during all excavation work.
 - b) Complete an archaeological impact assessment to be completed by a qualified, permitted archaeologist.
- 5. If it is suspected that remains of archaeological significance are found during construction, operation or maintenance of the proposed development, as per the <u>Heritage Conservation Act</u> (2010), all activity shall be stopped near the find and the Resource Manager of the Archaeological Services Unit shall be contacted at (506) 453-3014.
- 6. The proponent shall ensure that if a nest or chick of a migratory bird is detected, work in the area shall be halted and the Canadian Wildlife Service be consulted for advice at (902) 426-9152. The proponent shall ensure that activities are conducted in a manner that would be in compliance with the Migratory Birds Convention Act.
- 7. The proponent shall apply for and obtain a *Watercourse and Wetland Alteration (WAWA) Permit* from DELG for any activities conducted within 30 metres of a watercourse or wetland, prior to the commencement of the Project. - 8. The proponent shall ensure that any proposed project modifications are submitted for review and approval to the Manager, EA Section, DELG, prior to implementing the changes.
- 9. The proponent shall ensure that all developers, contractors and operators associated with the development project comply with the above requirements.
