

New Brunswick's interprovincial migrants aged 1 year and over

- Between 2015 and 2016, 10,585 individuals moved to New Brunswick from elsewhere in the country, with the majority of them coming from Ontario (26.7%), Alberta (21.6%) and Nova Scotia (18.3%).
- At the same time, 10,445 people left New Brunswick for other parts of Canada. Most of these individuals went to Ontario (27.6%), Nova Scotia (19.6%) and Alberta (16.4%).
- While the number of people coming to New Brunswick was similar to the number leaving, more arrived than left. The province experienced a slight gain (+140) in its migration exchanges with other jurisdictions in Canada.
