

SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The computerized numerical controls machinist occupation includes

- (a) the interpreting of geometrical tolerancing and dimensioning;
- (b) the interpreting of blueprints, schematic drawings and symbols specific to the computerized numerical controls machinist occupation;
- (c) the applying of quality management principles;
- (d) the measuring of parts and components;
- (e) the applying of basic programming and editing principles for centres of computerized numerical controls;
- (f) the executing of programs on centres of computerized numerical controls;
- (g) the operating of centres of computerized numerical controls; and
- (h) the operating of any other machine related to the computerized numerical controls machinist occupation.
