

### SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The ironworker (reinforcing) occupation includes

- (a) the cutting, bending, layout and placing of reinforcing rods, wire fabric and composite materials;
- (b) the placing and stressing of post-tensioning systems;
- (c) the rigging of loads and directing of crane operators when installing reinforcing and post-tensioning components;
- (d) the applying of sealants, where applicable;
- (e) the tacking, burning and edge preparation of ferrous and non-ferrous metals;
- (f) the selecting, erecting and dismantling of scaffolding; and
- (g) the interpreting of blueprints and symbols.
