

### SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The roofer occupation includes

- (a) the applying of built-up roofs, the laying of vapour barriers and insulation, the securing, mopping, stripping and gravelling of roofs, including the fabricating and installing of all sheet metal roof related flashings;
- (b) the applying of asphalt saturated shingles;
- (c) the applying of modified bitumen roofing systems;
- (d) the applying of single ply roofing systems including EPDM (ethylene propylene diene monomer) and PVC (polyvinyl chloride) membranes;
- (e) the installing of tapered roof insulation systems in accordance with the manufacturer's layout drawings;
- (f) the applying of membrane waterproofing to foundation walls, floor slabs and bridge decks;
- (g) the inspecting of problem roofs and determining the extent and procedure of repairing or removing and replacing;
- (h) the installing of all roof drain inserts and drain clamps;
- (i) the installing of roof accessories, roof vent flashings and anchor bolt flashings;
- (j) the interpreting of blueprints and specifications; and
- (k) the working in coordination with allied occupations engaged in construction.
