

Signs on Other Highways

Private signs are allowed one metre outside the right-of-way on highways other than Level I and Level II [controlled access highways](#), such as local named roads and numbered routes provided the business operation being signed meets certain eligibility criteria. Formatted signs are not a requirement on these other highways although DTI still regulates such things as the message, size, location, spacing, and the distance from the sign to the business operation being signed. A permit is required from DTI in order to install one of these signs along any arterial or collector highway.
